Without Catastrophic there are some important covers excluded like: Chemotherapy, dialysis or extra costs by Heart surgeries, Neurology as well as all diagnosis in high cost area. There is no the Dental plan or Pharmacy Plan included!

If possible keep in your home country a low budget Health insurance to cover the basics in catastrophic events.

- Blood, Prosthesis, Contrast Color and special machines are not included in the cover!
- Price rising approximately 10% per year, depending on inflation (mostly Feb-Mar)
